O2 Arena

Berlin

ChandlerKBS is providing the cost management and employer's agent services for the exciting new build of one of the most modern multi-functional arenas in Europe. Situated in the heart of the new urban guarter at Ostbahnhof, Berlin, construction commenced in September 2006 and is scheduled for completion in summer 2008.

The €150 million O2 World Arena will be the venue for numerous sports, music and entertainment events, with the capacity to

hold approximately 17,000 spectators. The façade will be transformed into a mammoth video screen and it is planned to hold up to 150 events per year. During the first 3 years of operation, over 3 million visitors are expected to attend more than 300 events.

A partnership between Anschutz Entertainment Group and O2 Germany will give the German Capital a venue for the high-profile national and international sporting and entertainment events that it has long sought.

British Nuclear Group

Trawsfynydd

ChandlerKBS was commissioned in 2004 to work with British Nuclear Group at their Trawsfynydd site in North Wales to introduce a new approach to procurement and collaborative working in the nuclear decommissioning arena.

The work at Trawsfynydd continues on this and other projects, providing project and cost management assistance. ChandlerKBS has broadened and deepened its association with British Nuclear Group to assist other decommissioning sites in the formulation of their procurement strategies.

ChandlerKBS is currently assisting British Nuclear Group at all of its Magnox North sites (Hunterston, Chapelcross, Wylfa, Trawsfynydd, Oldbury) and at Berkeley in Magnox South with procurement events for major construction and decommissioning projects. In addition, ChandlerKBS provides NEC Contract training, staff skills assessments, collaborative behaviour training and leadership development.

N8 Cullahill to Cashel

Dublin and Cork

ChandlerKBS is providing cost management services for this €165 million scheme which forms part of the South-Western Corridor, linking the principal cities of Dublin and Cork. As part of the core national inter-urban network, the National Development Plan identified this corridor as the longest new motorway project to be built in Ireland.

At 40 km in length, the N8/M8 Cullahill to Cashel project consists of 30 km of two-lane dual carriageway and 10 km of motorway, with separated junctions, underbridges and overbridges. Including this scheme, there is a total of 112km new road projects either completed or under construction along the N8 corridor in Ireland.


Silverburn Centre

Glasgow

ChandlerKBS is providing the due diligence and project monitoring services for the redevelopment of the Silverburn Centre formally known as the Pollok shopping centre in Glasgow, Scotland.

The £350 million scheme aims to be among the top 10 best performing and will be the ninth largest shopping centre in the UK, helping to generate local employment.

Due for completion in 2008, it will be a single level mall with double height shop fronts giving it a high street feel as well as providing a piazza and a winter garden for relaxing.



Vets Now Dunfermline

ChandlerKBS is providing the cost management services for Vets Now, an out of hours veterinary emergency and critical care centre for sick or injured pets.

With 26 clinics based throughout the UK, this £2 million project comprises the construction of a 2 storey open plan office block to become Vets Now's administrative headquarters and call centre. The building will also provide meeting rooms, a lecture theatre and a training room. The site is located on the eastern outskirts of Dunfermline and is part of the recently constructed Masterton Business Park.



Project update

Breidenbacher Hof Hotel Düsseldorf

The redevelopment of this legendary hotel has been underway for eleven months with ChandlerKBS taking on the cost and project management, development management and client representative roles.

The construction work of all 3 basement levels, ground and first floor are now complete. The apartment marketing has now begun and the hotel is on track for the completion date of December this year.



An interesting historical development is the discovery of a small sandstone section of the historic city wall of Düsseldorf which was uncovered last year, during excavation for the hotel's new foundation and substreet levels. In consultation with the City of Düsseldorf, construction plans have been modified to allow a reconstructed portion of the original wall to be on view from a retail area of the project below street level.



International Sports village

ChandlerKBS is continuing to provide cost, project and procurement services for this exciting £1 billion leisure scheme. With work progressing at a fast pace all the surrounding roadworks are now complete. The Morrison supermarket and temporary ice rink have opened in the last few months, and the swimming pool is half way through to completion. Future phases of work will include residential development, waterfront bars, restaurants and retail sites.
